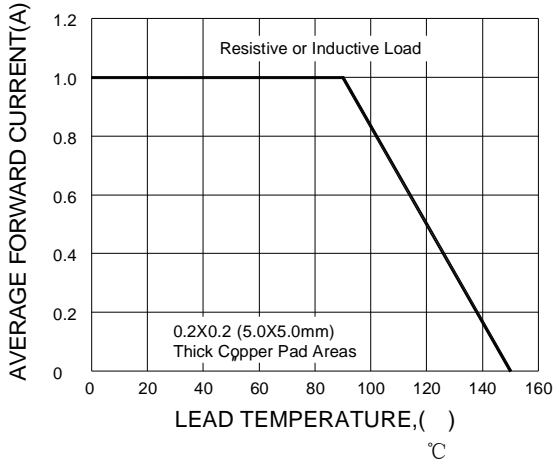

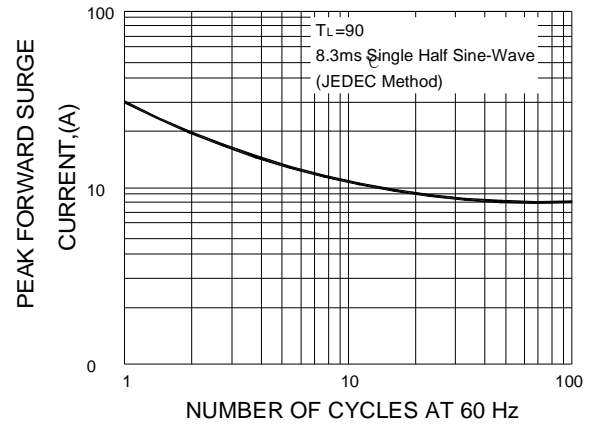

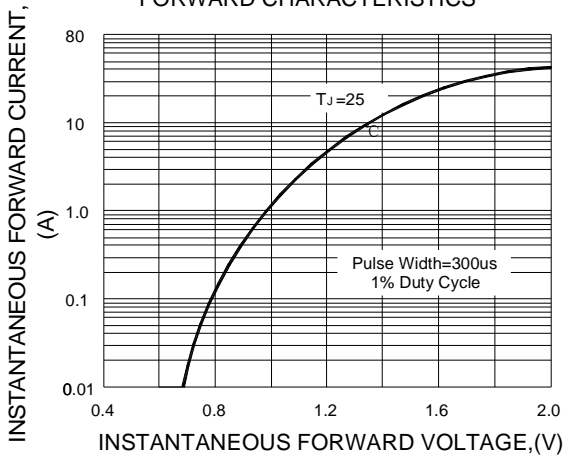
F1G.1-FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE



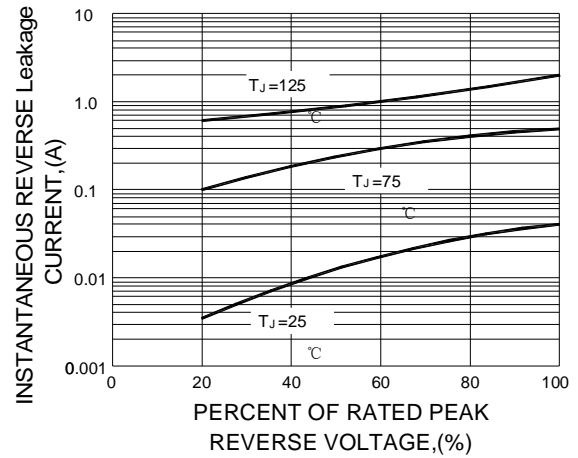
F1G.2-MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE PEAK FORWARD SURGE CURRENT



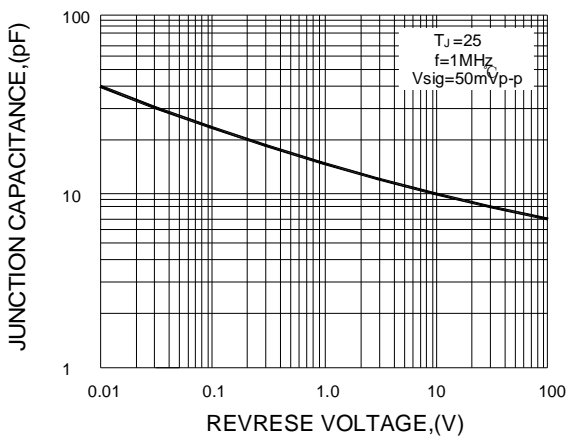
F1G.3-TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS
